





BONFIRE NIGHT Speaking Exam Practice

In this section, the children can practise the skills they will need for the Speaking Test of the **Cambridge Young Learners English Tests.** This month, the focus is on part 2 of the **Movers** Speaking Test.

In this part of the exam, the examiner shows the children a sequence of four pictures and describes the first picture in the story. The child then describes the other three pictures. Note that the children only have to say a few words about each picture. The structures they are expected to use are:

- there is/are
- present tense of the verbs be and have (got)
- modals can
- can't and must/mustn't
- present continuous of some action verbs

They should also be able to describe simple feelings. In this activity, the story they are describing is about bonfire night. The children can work in pairs to describe the sequence. You can help them by writing useful vocabulary on the board.
