Activity 2

Photo frame

You will need:

- one copy of Worksheet 1 for each child (preferably on card)
- coloured crayons, pencils or markers
- scissors or paper punches

Instructions:

- 1 Distribute Worksheet 1 to your students.
- 2 Ask the children to colour in the pictures. You may want them to write '2010' after 'HALLOWEEN' or you can write it in before doing the photocopies.
- 3 Ask the children to cut out the frame.
- 4 Either ask the children to draw themselves in the centre of the frame or, if they dress up, take photos of them. Alternatively, ask them to affix a photo at home and to bring back the frame to show you and the rest of the class.

You could also suggest they use one of the pictures from Activity 1.

Optional extension activity

Prepare a box of Halloween props (a witch's hat, a mask...). You can prepare these yourself or ask the children to each bring something in. If you wish, you can enlarge the pictures from activity 1 and make them into masks. Ask the children to sit in a circle and give one of the children an object (for example, a toy brick). Play some music. When the music stops, the child with the object must pick something out of the box and put it on. You could also suggest they put their prop on the floor and only put it on when everyone has a prop. At the end of the game, you can take a photo of the whole class wearing the props. If you have a large class, two objects can be passed round at the same time so that the game takes half the time.
